What is the TEDP?

The Telecommunications Equipment Distribution Program (TEDP) provides telecommunication devices for individuals who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, or have a speech impairment. The equipment is free to qualified Alaska residents. It helps consumers connect with anyone, restoring their confidence and independence through advanced technologies.

Who is eligible for the TEDP?

Only one piece of equipment is allotted per subscriber line. To take advantage of the TEDP, you must:

- be an Alaska resident.
- have a significant hearing loss or speech impairment.
- have a communication disorder which severely interferes with communicating effectively over the telephone, as certified by a physician, audiologist, speech-language pathologist, or Department of Health and Social Services.
- complete an application form and send to the address shown on the last page.

Failure to complete the application form correctly or completely may cause a delay in getting the equipment. Please print clearly and legibly.
