## **Just dial 711!**

If you are a hearing person and you want to call people who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, deaf-blind, late-deafened or who have a speech disability, all you have to do is dial **711**. It is that easy! (If the phone from which you are calling does not accept **711**, just call **1-800-770-8255** for the same great results).

## **Follow these simple steps:**

1. Dial 711 (or 1-800-770-8255).
2. A specially trained Alaska Relay Communication Assistant (CA) will answer and identify themselves by their CA number.
3. Give the CA the phone number of the person you are calling.
4. The CA will connect you with the person you are calling and will assist you with communication.

## **It really is that easy!**

Remember, calls can be made to anywhere in the world, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. All calls are strictly confidential and no records of any conversation are maintained. Long distance calls are billed at a discounted rate.
